### Airport Update

### **Taxiway A Rehab Construction Update**

Russ Holliday with Avcon addressed the Board and presented them with the Taxiway Alpha Rehab update. Holliday explained the funding was for approximately \$4.67 million and FAA will fund 100% of the project. Holliday stated the project was awarded to Dickerson of Florida to construct the project and it currently was in the procurement and permitting phase. Holliday noted there was a delay with the electrical and the vault materials. Holliday estimated the start of the construction would be around the second week of April. Holliday explained the four phases and the stated the phases helped with funding. Minshew advised the City would be sending letters to the tenants regarding the construction date in mid-April. Holliday advised the Board provisions had been made for a stand by generator.

Discussion was had on more hangars, hangar repairs and jet fuel.

# **FAA Pre-App for AWOS-II Construction**

Holliday advised the Board the FAA funding commitment was currently in question. The deadline was April 11, 2022 and the amount for the project was \$350,000.

Cobb asked about the B&B hangar. Grimes stated it was rented by another tenant who used it for spraying.
