

Historic Preservation Board Minutes
City of Wauchula
February 19, 2010

The Wauchula Historic Preservation Board met Friday, February 19, 2010 at 2:00 p.m. The following members were present: Preston, Hancock-Ackerly, Royal and Collins. Peavy was absent. Also present was Barry Edgley.

Preston called the meeting to order.

The Board reviewed an application for a Certificate of Appropriateness for a new sign to be installed at 219 E. Main Street. Barry Edgley was the applicant and the business owner of Stitch 'n Sign. The sign will be mounted on the wall. Royal made the motion, seconded by Hancock-Ackerly to approve the Certificate of Appropriateness. All were in favor. Motion carried.

The Board reviewed an application for a Certificate of Appropriateness for a sign face replacement at 216 – 222 W. Main Street. Barry Edgley was the applicant representing the business owner of Cracker Pub & Grille. He is the sign contractor. Collins made the motion, seconded by Hancock-Ackerly to approve the Certificate of Appropriateness. All were in favor. Motion carried.

The Board reviewed an application for a Certificate of Appropriateness to paint the trim on the building located at 116 – 120 W. Main Street “USF” Green. The trim is currently dark brown. The building will be the future location of One Poly Place for USF Polytechnic. Collins indicated that she works part time for USF Polytechnic. Minshew had received approval from the City attorney that that would not be considered a conflict of interest for Collins to vote on the Certificate of Appropriateness. Minshew stated that she did not expect anyone to attend the meeting for this item. Jessica Newman, the Main Street Wauchula Director, brought it to her attention because the project had applied for grant funds from Main Street Wauchula. Royal made the motion, seconded by Hancock-Ackerly to approve the Certificate of Appropriateness. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Hancock-Ackerly made the motion, seconded by Collins to approve the minutes from October 20, 2009. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Being no further discussion, the meeting was adjourned.
