Resolution 2022-33 – Extending the State of Emergency due to Hurricane Ian

Request Authorization to Utilize Contingency Funds from the General and Utility Funds

Atchley addressed the Commission and explained the request. Atchley explained there was damaged not covered by insurance nor FEMA. Braxton explained there was approximately \$300,000 in contingency. Nadaskay asked if the items purchased could be tracked. G. Smith asked how much of the contingency fund would be used. Braxton stated staff did not know. Braxton noted all of it may be used and more may be needed from reserves.

Cobb motioned to approve the utilization of contingency funds from the General and Utility funds, seconded by G. Smith.
