

The Wauchula Historic Preservation Board met Monday, February 12, 2018 at 5:00 p.m.

The following members were present: Raafat Zakhary, Chair Tanya Royal, Dr. Sylvia Collins, and William Boynton.

Board Members Jennifer Clark, Cynthia Paxton and Linda Burnett were absent.

Also present were Community Development Coordinator Kyle Long and Deputy City Clerk Victoria Thompson.

Royal called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

Certificate of Appropriateness – 213 W Main Street – Exterior Paint/Brick Color:

Collins motioned to accept the Certificate of Appropriateness, seconded by Boynton.

Much discussion was held among the Board and Mr. Clay Cobb regarding the color tones he requested to use on the building he is currently constructing. He noted how similar his color choices were to those of a building currently under renovation on Main Street. Boynton felt the colors chosen did not suit the building to which Collins agreed; stating the gray of the brick was too dark.

With no other discussion, Royal called for all in favor.

Royal was the only aye vote.

For those opposed, like sign; Zakhary, Collins and Boynton voted nay.

Motion failed to carry 1 - 3.
